A rare and historic property, Villa Argentina, originally known as the "Chalet des Trois Sœurs", is an outstanding Belle Époque manor house completed around 1884 within the prestigious Baillénx Estate of Salies-de-Béarn. Designed by renowned architect Xavier Saint-Guil, this remarkable residence offers approximately 300 m² of living space across four levels, surrounded by 4,813 m² of beautifully landscaped grounds featuring a stream flowing into the Saleys River, a bamboo grove, and mature trees. Original oak staircases, high ceilings, fireplaces, period parquet floors, and modern comforts combine to create a unique living environment. A separate caretaker's cottage with garage offers excellent potential for guest accommodation or thermal-spa rentals. Within walking distance of the town centre, thermal baths, golf course, casino, shops and restaurants, this exceptional property perfectly blends heritage, elegance and lifestyle.

Nestled in the heart of Salies-de-Béarn, one of the most charming spa towns in South-West France, Villa Argentina invites you to discover an exceptional piece of local history.

Originally known as the "Chalet des Trois Sœurs" (Three Sisters Chalet), this elegant Belle Époque manor house was completed around 1884 within the prestigious Baillénx development, envisioned by the Count of Baillénx as an exclusive residential district for wealthy visitors attracted by the town's famous thermal waters. The project was entrusted to architect Xavier Saint-Guily, who would later design the renowned Hôtel du Parc, one of Salies-de-Béarn's landmark buildings.

Behind its electric wrought-iron gates, the property unfolds within a stunning 4,813 m² private park. A picturesque stream meanders through the grounds before joining the Saleys River, while a beautiful bamboo grove and numerous mature trees create a peaceful and enchanting setting throughout the seasons.

The main residence offers approximately 300 m² of living space arranged over four levels.

Upon entering, visitors are immediately captivated by the magnificent solid oak staircase, a striking architectural feature that reflects the elegance and prestige of the period.
