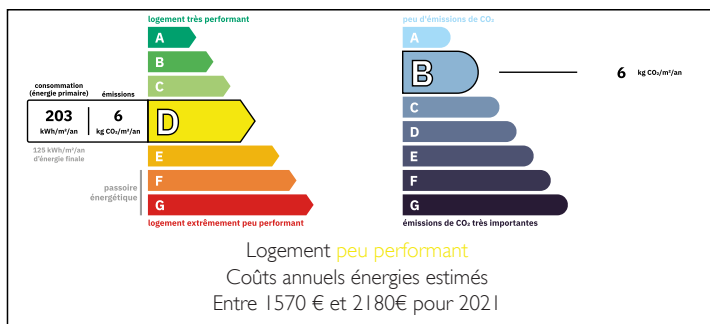


Exceptional Perigord Estate with Panoramic Views and Conversion Barn

IN BRIEF

Nestled in a secluded setting on the heights of Plazac, within approximately one hectare of land, this authentic 19th-century Perigord stone house comes with a barn and enjoys superb open views across the valley.

Offering around 180 m² of living space, the property features a kitchen with fireplace, a cosy living room, a spacious glazed reception room with a wood-burning stove, four bedrooms, two shower rooms, one bathroom and four toilets. A utility room equipped with a recent heat pump completes the accommodation.

The house retains all the charm of a traditional Perigord home, with exposed beams, solid wood flooring and a beautiful stone fireplace.

Outside, the property benefits from a landscaped garden, a dry-stone terrace, a natural spring and a barn with planning permission for conversion.

DESCRIPTION

This charming property enjoys exceptional panoramic views over the Côte de Jor, the lake and the medieval village of Plazac. A large shaded terrace welcomes you before entering the house.

The accommodation is arranged as follows:

On the ground floor, featuring traditional terracotta floor tiles, you will find an entrance hall, a separate WC, an open-plan kitchen with a stone fireplace, a cosy living room, and a magnificent fully glazed living area of approximately 35 m² with breathtaking views and a wood-burning stove. This level also includes a master bedroom with an en-suite shower room and WC.

Upstairs, a landing leads to two further bedrooms and a family bathroom with WC.

On the garden level, an additional bedroom with its own shower room and WC, accessible independently from outside, provides ideal guest accommodation. This floor also includes a utility room and a boiler room.

The property benefits from an air-to-water heat pump, a water softener, double-glazed windows and traditional wooden shutters.

As for the outbuildings, the property includes a barn of approximately 45 m² with potential for conversion into additional living accommodation (plans available), a wood store and an attic.

A natural spring provides an independent water source, ideal for filling a future swimming pool or irrigating the garden.

Ideally located in the heart of the Golden Triangle of the Périgord Noir, this sought-after property combines tranquillity with convenience. It is close to Buddhist retreat centres, local amenities and many of the region's most popular tourist attractions.
