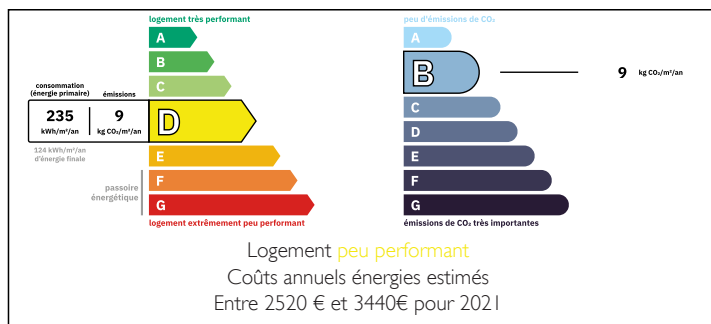

Tucked away on the prettiest street in Durfort, with a striking colombage facade, you will find this delightful property, full of potential.

The ground floor has a large reception room with French doors onto the street as well as a separate entrance into the corridor. Another room could be converted into a kitchen or ground floor bedroom, with traditional stone walls providing plenty of character. To the rear of the ground floor, there are two rooms that require renovation.

A solid wooden staircase leads to the first floor where there is a spacious kitchen that opens onto a living room with a wood burning insert and more character features with the beams and stone walls. There is a bathroom, an adjoining toilet and utility room that requires renovation.

On the top floor there are two bedrooms with access to a shower room. The larger bedroom has sliding doors onto a spacious roof terrace with a barbecue and views over the village and the hills around the property.

There is some renovation work required; the first-floor utility and toilet require a new floor following water damage, and the property could use some general refreshing throughout. The price reflects this work, and the property has the potential to be a delightful home or holiday home in a beautiful setting.
