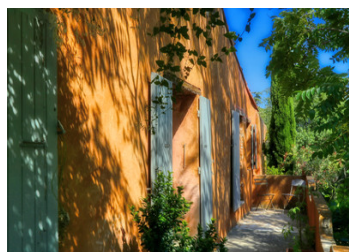
IN BRIEF

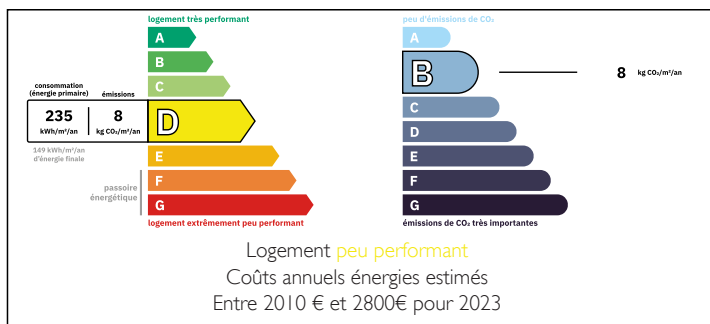
