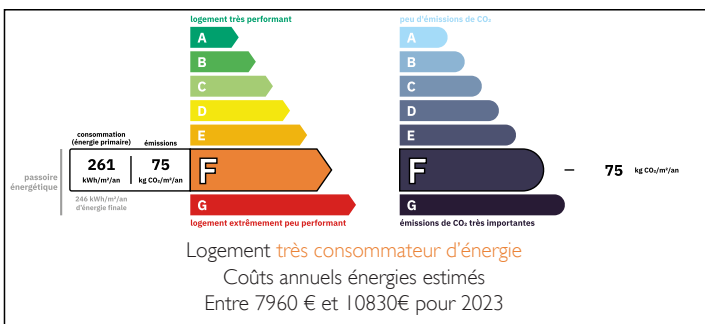

The house immediately impresses with its architecture, façade, generous volumes, and panoramic terraces. Designed either as a single family home or as two separate living spaces, it also benefits from a vast full basement of approximately 350 m<sup>2</sup>.

## DESCRIPTION

In one of the most sought-after areas of the Périgord Noir, set in the heart of a remarkable and preserved natural environment, this rare property offers a particularly desirable concept: bringing together within a single estate a quality residence, an independent professional facility, and extensive leisure grounds.

The estate extends over more than 28,000 m<sup>2</sup> of parkland, meadows, and natural riverside surroundings. The layout of the property provides remarkable versatility, suitable for residential, professional, or tourism-related use.

The main house immediately appeals with its traditional Périgourdine architecture, light stone façades, harmonious volumes, and landscaped garden. Built over several levels, it has been designed to function either as a large family home or as two fully independent living units. Each level includes its own reception areas, kitchens, bedrooms, and bathrooms.

Constructed in the 1960s to particularly high building standards, the main residence offers generous volumes and an excellent layout.

It is built over a vast full basement of nearly 350 m<sup>2</sup> at garden level, providing extensive garage space, storage areas, workshops, a cellar, and technical rooms. This rare surface area is a major asset for a professional activity, a car collection, leisure use, or future development.
