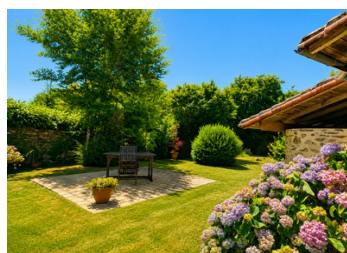

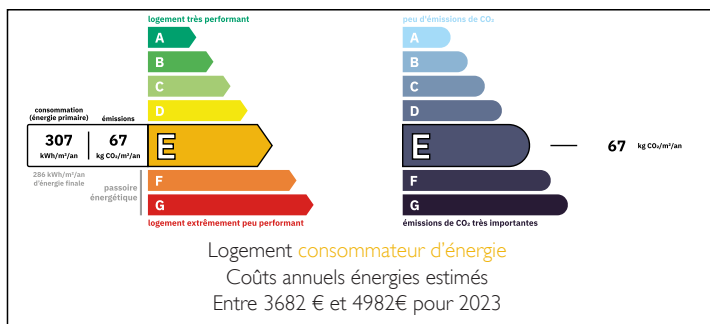
IN BRIEF

Full of authentic character, the cottage has retained many of its original features and is complemented by a beautifully established garden that provides a tranquil and inviting outdoor retreat.

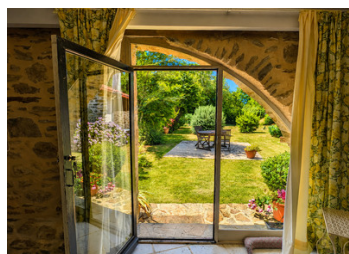

DESCRIPTION

Private from the roadside, this enchanting stone cottage is hidden behind a lush, established garden filled with mature plants and shrubs, creating a true haven of peace. Typical of the local architecture, the property captures the charm of a bygone era while offering the comforts of modern living, including central heating, a pellet stove, triple glazing, and mains drainage.

At the heart of the home is a beautiful French country kitchen featuring a traditional cuisinière and a central dining table, perfect for relaxed family meals. The kitchen flows into a stunning double-height living room with exposed stone walls and oak beams. Above, a cosy mezzanine bedroom benefits from a Velux roof window fitted with an electric shutter.

The ground floor also includes a practical storage cupboard, a cloakroom, and a bathroom finished with handcrafted tiles.

Adjoining one side of the cottage is a garage, where a garden-facing bedroom has been created. On the opposite side, an independent barn also offers a bedroom opening directly onto the garden. Subject to the necessary planning permissions, these outbuildings offer exciting potential for further development.

Sold furnished and lovingly maintained throughout, this delightful property offers an idyllic slice of French country life, combining timeless character with everyday comfort.
