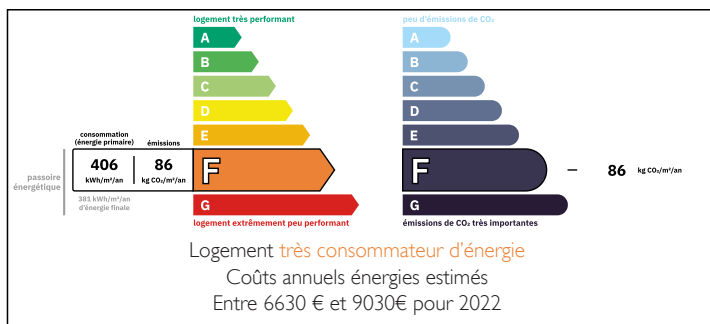

DESCRIPTION

The property nestles on the edge of the Morvan Regional Park in between Autun and Amay de Duc, just half an hour from the A6 Motorway.

The property offers a spacious interior with 3 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms and separate W.C. A bedroom and a wheelchair-friendly wet room are situated on the ground floor.

A spacious kitchen diner with separate utility area and very large lounge with a fireplace and wood burning stove complete the ground floor.

The first floor currently opens into a huge room previously used as a library and reading area which leads to 2 further bedrooms, one of which with a private balcony.

There is a garage and workshop, storage sheds and stables for 2 horses as well as off-street parking for at least 5 cars.

The grounds include a sprawling garden with mature fruit trees and vegetable garden. Wrapped around all this is a 3000m² field which has been used for many things from grazing the horses to hosting the local car boot sale.

The towns of Autun and Arnay le Duc have absolutely everything including: Hypermarkets, railway station, supermarkets, hospitals, doctors, vets, banks, post office, all positioned around a beautiful and lively town squares with many restaurants and bars to choose from.
