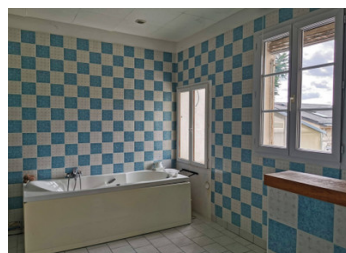


Character Town House in the Historic Market Town of Montrichard, Loire Valley

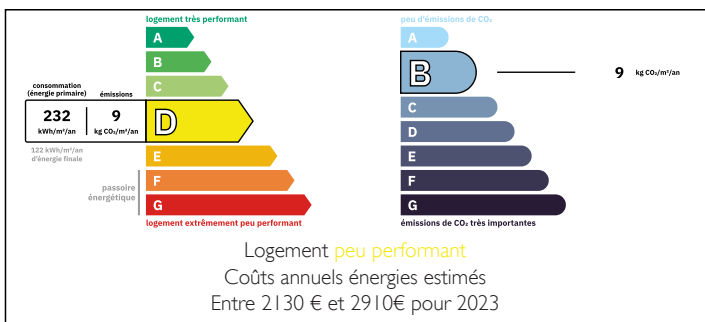
IN BRIEF

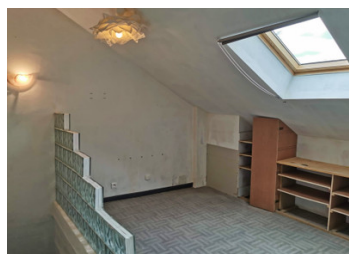

DESCRIPTION

The house retains many authentic features, including exposed beams, traditional tuffeau stone walls, original timber details and a wealth of character throughout. The accommodation is arranged over several levels and offers flexible living space ready to be adapted to suit individual requirements.

The ground floor includes a spacious living area with period features, while the kitchen opens onto a bright additional reception space illuminated by roof windows. Upstairs, further rooms provide potential for bedrooms, office space or hobby rooms.

Outside, the property benefits from a separate outdoor area, reached by a short walk up the hill, providing a pleasant space to sit and enjoy the surroundings. This area also includes a traditional troglodyte cave carved into the rock, a distinctive feature of the Loire Valley, offering excellent potential for wine storage or a workshop.

The property would benefit from updating and cosmetic improvements throughout. In addition, access between floors is via a very narrow staircase, which may not suit all buyers and should be carefully considered by anyone with mobility concerns or those requiring easier access.

For buyers seeking an authentic French lifestyle, the location is difficult to beat. Montrichard sits at the heart of the Loire Valley and provides easy access to some of France's most celebrated attractions, including Château de Chenonceau, Château de Chambord, Château de Cheverny and the world-renowned Beauval ZooParc. The surrounding area is also famous for its vineyards, riverside walks, cycling routes and picturesque villages.
