Located on a charming street in the heart of historic Bordeaux, this townhouse extends over three levels and offers approximately 260 m² of floor area.

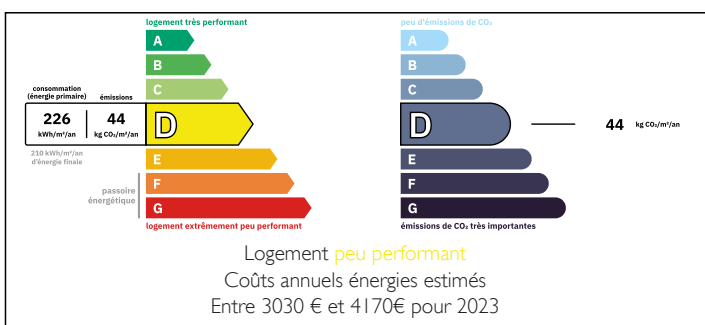
The ground floor comprises an entrance hall and two large spaces currently used as a music studio and workshop, representing more than 90 m² of floor space (offering many possible uses).

The upper floor provides three bedrooms, a study, a family bathroom, a dressing room and circulation areas. A mezzanine level completes the accommodation.
