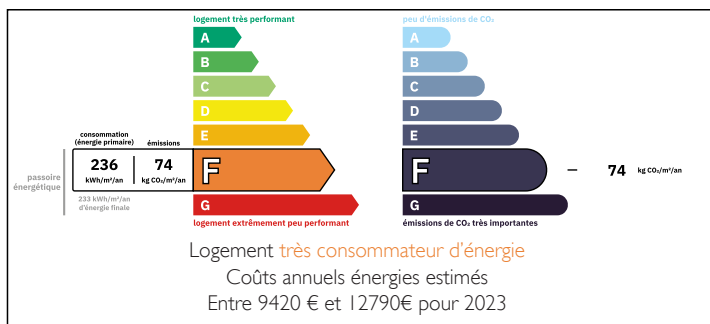
IN BRIEF
