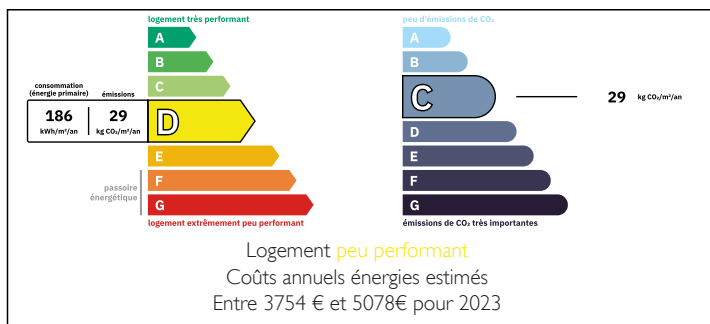

IN BRIEF

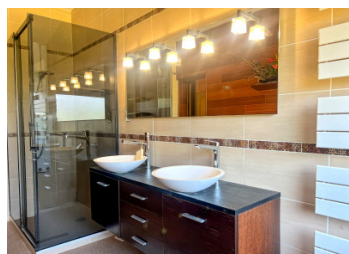
Truly a rare find - a spacious, bright Art Deco house from 1930, 15 mins from Pau in the centre of Bizanos. This is a sophisticated, grown-up home with elegant, generously proportioned entertaining spaces and luxurious finishes. From the solarium with cathedral ceiling, the living/dining room with art deco style fireplace to the custom-designed kitchen with granite worktops opening onto another dining/sitting area with marble fireplace, the choice is large. A master bedroom and bathroom, 2 separate WCs, an entrance hall, garage and laundry space complete the ground floor. In the basement is a wine cellar and a further room. Upstairs is a bedroom with ensuite bathroom, a study, and two further bedrooms, one of which is a dressing room with shower room. Outside, a mature, fully enclosed garden with trees, shrubs and flowers surrounds the house...

DESCRIPTION

Beyond the front door, an elegant entrance hall opens into a spectacular solarium, flooded with natural light and crowned by a striking cathedral ceiling. A discreet guest WC is conveniently positioned off the hallway - a total of about 45m² in all

The ground floor has been thoughtfully designed for effortless living and entertaining, with beautifully connected reception spaces that create a warm yet sophisticated atmosphere. The 37.5 m² living room features two large windows overlooking the landscaped garden and an impressive Art Deco-style fireplace, providing a stunning focal point.

The ground-floor principal suite offers a spacious bedroom with garden views, a generous bathroom with walk-in shower, and a separate WC, creating a private and comfortable retreat.

The bespoke kitchen opens onto a welcoming dining and sitting area and is enhanced by a charming marble fireplace, windows on all sides, and direct access to the garden. It is also connected to the integral garage, making everyday life particularly convenient. Designed to a high standard, the kitchen features granite worktops, extensive storage, and quality appliances. A practical laundry area is located between the kitchen and garage.

At the heart of the house, the beautifully preserved original polished-wood staircase leads to a spacious landing. To the left is an impressive library with traditional fitted wooden bookshelves, adjoining a study. Beyond lies a second suite with garden views and an en-suite bathroom.
