Meneac is a small town with a few bars and restaurants, a pharmacy, medical centre and a small convenience store. It also has a huge lake, ideal for fisherman. Permits are available from the Meneac town hall (Mairie). Situated in the middle of Brittany, it is a drive of less than an hour to the Southern Brittany coast at Vannes or the North Brittany coast at Val Andre. Also provides easy access to the medieval town of Josselin, Rennes or Ploermel.

DESCRIPTION

The property itself is as follows:

The floor of the property has cement floor slabs and is currently semi divided into three areas. The main living area, a kitchen and a bathroom each of which need fully renovated. The attic space is large with high ceiling but currently no staircase to access. Once renovated the property could have 120m2 of habitable space.

The property has character features of exposed beams and a large open fireplace, just waiting to form the basis of a new home.

Water and electricity are linked to the house but need to be reconnected. There is no septic tank but the preliminary paperwork has been completed for the installation.

Adjacent to the property is a piece of land of 400m2, ideal to make a garden or vegetable plot.
