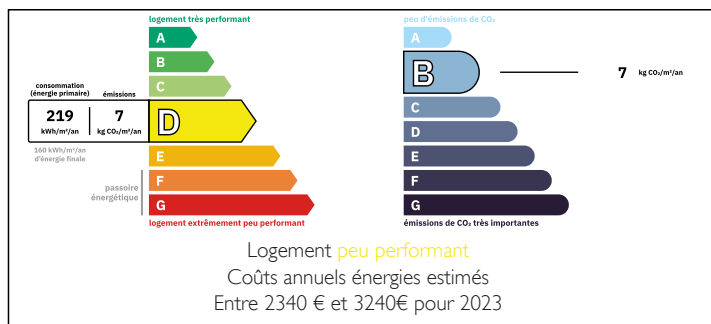
IN BRIEF

Above-ground steel swimming pool on a wooden deck.

A rare property, notable for the meticulous renovation using eco-friendly materials, its layout, grounds, swimming pool and outbuildings. Situated south of Lake Guerledan, a stone's throw from the Nantes-Brest Canal and Bon Repos Abbey, in a splendid rolling, wooded setting, this magnificent and rare property is ready to fulfil all your plans!

DESCRIPTION

On the ground floor, this fully renovated farmhouse comprises an entrance hall, two bedrooms, a bathroom with a stucco-finished shower and a bath, a utility room, a separate toilet, and a fitted and equipped kitchen with underfloor heating.

Upstairs, accessed via a loft ladder, there is a 50m² attic space fitted out with OSB panelling and insulated with biotextile insulation, suitable for use as a games room or even a dormitory.

In the second section, extending from the kitchen, you will find a spacious area comprising a dining room and living room. You'll appreciate the comfort of the masonry stove made of firebricks with its built-in oven, as well as the functional decorative fireplace.

A beautiful staircase made of metal and firebricks leads to the upper floor, which features a large mezzanine bedroom, a shower room and toilet, and a fourth bedroom with a lovely view of the garden.

Outside, you'll appreciate the variety of the natural surroundings, a shed with a straw-insulated storeroom, a utility pavilion with a mezzanine, an adjoining timber-framed greenhouse, and, of course, the swimming pool on its 70m² wooden terrace
