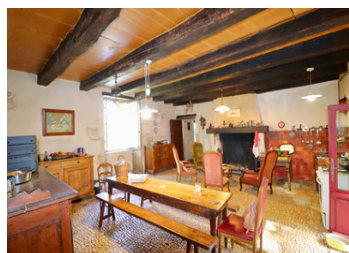

IN BRIEF

A beautiful detached. Logis dating from the 15th century. Comprises a detached main house of over 400m² habitable space, large open barn, piggery and adjoining park of almost 1.5 hectares.

The house includes spacious reception rooms, a large kitchen, a ground floor bedroom, bathroom with lavatory. Additional bedrooms and bathrooms are on the first floor. It has full oil-fired central heating as well as a few large stone fireplaces.. Some of the windows are double-glazed and all roofs were redone in 2018.

Outbuildings comprise a large barn and piggery. All the buildings are set in the middle of their own park which enjoys direct access to the Tardoire river. The land is mainly pasture with a number of fruit trees. A short tree-lined driveway leads to house and outbuildings.

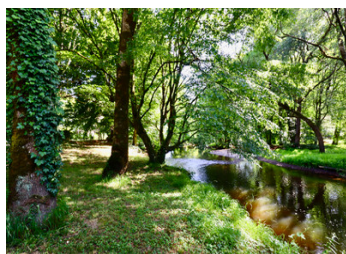

DESCRIPTION

Detached Logis type property comprising a main house, large hangar barn, piggery and attached plot of land with direct river access. Located in the commune of Moulins-Sur-Tardoire in the east of the Chaente department.

All buildings have new roofs, dating from 2018, and property is listed as a historical monument.

The Logis dates from the 15th century, has over 400m² habitable space, and retains many character features including wood beams, exposed stone walls, large stone fireplaces, a traditional Charentaise pebble floor and a lovely circular stone staircase.

The ground floor comprises:

An entrance hallway of 18.5m² which leads on to the remaining ground floor rooms and a beautiful stone staircase.

A kitchen/ diner of 38m² with large stone fireplace and pebble floor. A couple of smaller rooms lead off the kitchen. One is used as utility room (5.5m²) with the second being a larder/back kitchen (8m²).

A dining room of 34m² with tiled floor and access to the rear terrace/garden.

A room of 22.5m² with multiple entrances used as an office and with access to the rear garden.

A salon of 51m² with large stone fireplace and small boiler room of 6m² leading off it.

A bedroom of 17m² with ensuite bathroom of 6m² and lavatory.

The first floor comprises:

Independent large room of 40m², currently used as a library, with adjoining smaller room of 10m², used as a smaller library and leading on to a bathroom of 5m². This could be easily converted to become...
