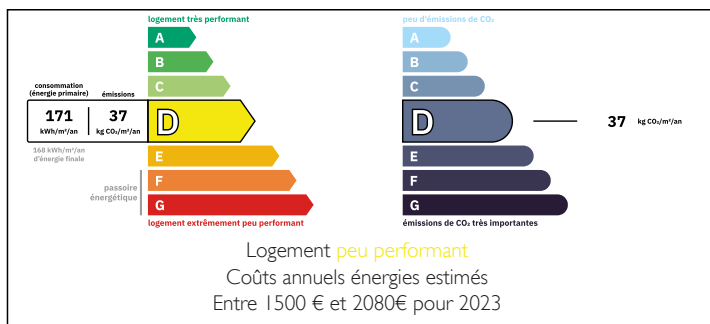

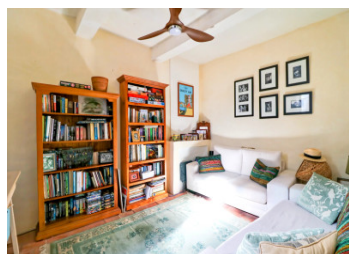

This charming village house offers approximately 95 m² of living space arranged over three levels and is full of authentic character. From the moment you step inside, the beautiful original stone flooring immediately sets the tone, reflecting the property's history and timeless appeal. Easy lock-up-and-leave holiday home or perfectly suitable for primary residency with 4 bedrooms and a private roof terrace.

The fully fitted and equipped kitchen is one of the home's most distinctive features, centred around an original stone well that remains in working order, an increasingly rare feature that adds considerable charm. The ground floor also includes a welcoming living and dining room, a spacious bedroom with an attractive fireplace, and a separate WC.

A beautiful traditional Cévenol staircase leads to the first floor, where you will find two comfortable bedrooms and a shower room with WC.

The top floor is dedicated to a generous fourth bedroom with its own private shower room, creating an ideal principal bedroom or guest suite. From here, you can step onto a lovely 14 m² roof terrace overlooking the rooftops of the village—a peaceful setting for outdoor dining, relaxing or simply enjoying the views.

The property is presented in excellent condition throughout, with no renovation work required. Individual gas central heating provides year-round comfort.
