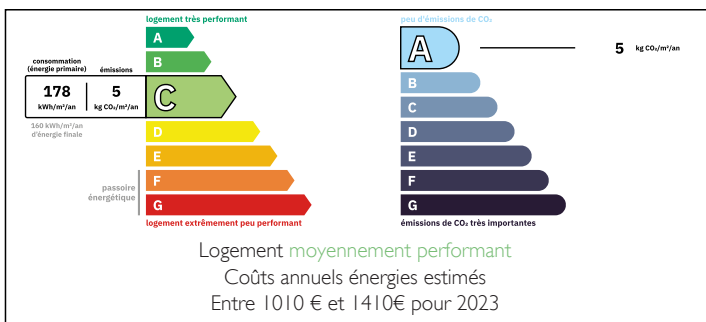

A large adjoining barn completes the property, offering great potential for a workshop, storage, a conversion project or any other idea you might have.

DESCRIPTION

On the ground floor:

1 entrance hall with a 3.5 m² storeroom on the right
This hall leads directly onto the patio and, in a row, to the 22 m² conservatory (winter garden)

1 separate kitchen measuring 14.5 m²

1 living room with a wood-burning stove, 40 m²

1 lounge/bedroom with a wood-burning stove, 18.5 m²

Upstairs

1 landing, 20 m²

2 bedrooms, 12.5 and 19 m²

1 utility room with WC, 6.5 m²

A full bathroom, 8.5 m²

Tiled floors on the ground floor

Wooden floors upstairs

The loft is insulated with hemp wool

Double glazing throughout the house

Heating via wood-burning stoves and electric heaters

As regards the outdoor areas

The first garden, accessible via the patio, is a former barn that has been demolished, leaving only the stone walls; it covers an area of approximately 200m².

The second garden, accessible via the veranda, features a large cistern and covers an area of 240m².

The third garden is accessible from the rear of the house and covers an area of 305m².

One barn, measuring 87m², is adjoining the house and could potentially be used to extend the house, create another dwelling, or for any other purpose...
