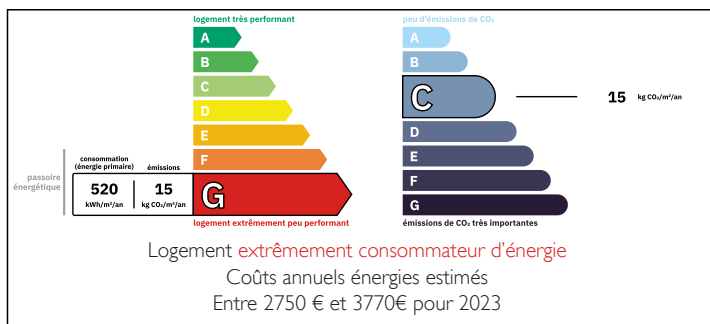
IN BRIEF

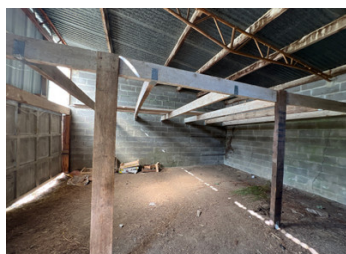

DESCRIPTION

Leaving the small, rural lane serving a few small hamlets dotted about, the property is around 600 meters from the nearest neighbouring dwelling.

Made up of two houses, various outbuildings, stabling, and barns, and a total of over 90 acres of land, all of which is close by. The majority of the land does have a tenancy agreement in place, but there are still nearly 20 acres soon to be free of tenancy next to the property which include a source and small lake.

The main house, needs some modernisation, but could be considered habitable and consists of a large entrance hall with WC, fitted kitchen, with scullery/laundry area behind, a lounge and dining room with fireplaces.

Upstairs, 3 large double bedrooms and a bathroom. Above, a large attic. To the front and side, gardens. Wood central heating, double glazing. The ground floor is tiled, upstairs has original parquet flooring. Structurally sound and a good roof.

The second house has a fitted kitchen, and living area on the ground floor. Two bedrooms on the first floor and a bedroom and shower room on the second floor. There is a terrace in front, a workshop and a barn/garage. This property has been rented but the tenancy ends Sept 2026.

Outside, various outbuildings, some of which could potentially be converted into gîtes, stables, shippen, barns, menage, bread oven, vaulted cave. These outbuildings would house animals or could be used for some alternative commercial venture.
