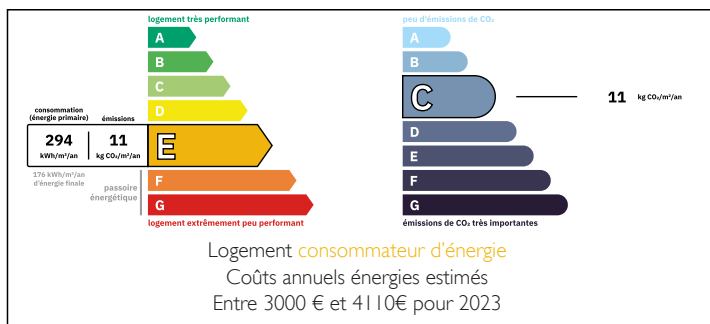
The Exterior

Interior Spaces

Large Living Room / Family Room: An impressive centrepiece with a cathedral ceiling, featuring a magnificent, monumental fireplace with a stone mantelpiece and exposed flue, enhanced by sturdy solid timber beams and terracotta tiled flooring. (30 m2)

Kitchen: A bright, separate kitchen, fitted with wooden units, featuring painted beams and direct access to the living areas. (13,5 m2)

Additional rooms: Multi-purpose spaces with exposed stone walls, storage and access to the outside. (17 m2)

Upper Floor / Mezzanines:

A lovely mezzanine area overlooking the living room, secured by a wooden balustrade, beneath exposed traditional roof timbers. (27 m2)

A second space under the eaves with laminate flooring, ideal for a bedroom, a study or a reading corner. (14 m2)

Features & Comfort

High-quality materials: Exposed stonework, timber roof structure, terracotta tiles.

Heating: Open fire/stove and electric convector heaters installed.

Light: Large openings and windows ensuring plenty of natural light in the main rooms.
