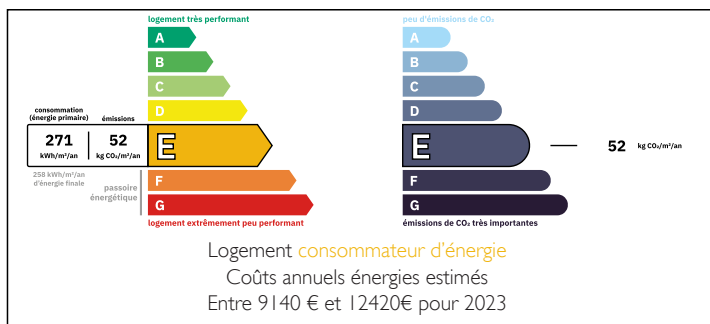

DESCRIPTION

Standing proudly in an elevated position in the heart of the charming village of Exireuil, this elegant 19th Century French château enjoys beautiful open views towards the historic market town of Saint-Maixent-l'École. Combining timeless architecture with generous living space and over 43,037m² (just over 4 hectares) of gardens, woodland and parkland, this is a rare opportunity to acquire an exceptional country estate in one of the most accessible areas of Nouvelle-Aquitaine.

The château has been carefully maintained while retaining the character and grandeur expected from a property of this period. High ceilings, decorative mouldings, original parquet flooring, impressive fireplaces and the magnificent double-revolution staircase all contribute to its unique charm.

The accommodation extends over three floors, providing substantial and versatile living space.

The ground floor centres around the impressive entrance hall and staircase, leading to elegant reception rooms, a spacious dining room, fitted kitchen, utility areas, boiler room, WC and additional service rooms. The layout lends itself equally well to family life and entertaining.

The first floor offers five generous bedrooms, including two with en-suite bathrooms, together with a further family bathroom and separate WC.

The second floor provides four additional bedrooms, one with a shower room, together with a further bathroom and separate WC and grenier, making the château ideal for large families, multi-generational living or guest accommodation.

Two of the second-floor bedrooms each have their own private staircase leading into the château's towers, where delightful turret rooms create unique character spaces ideal for storage, reading rooms or simply...
