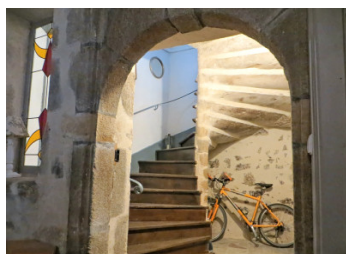

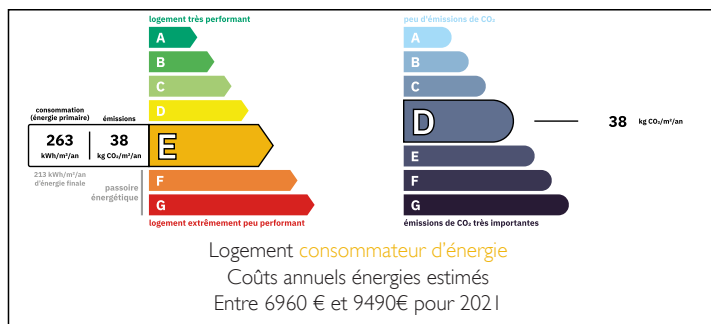

In a quiet lane a few steps from the centre of town, this elegant property will provide you with everything you need and all the amenities you want are within walking distance.

With parts of the house dating back to the 14th century and packed with character, this house also benefits from all the modernisation you would hope for, triple Glazing, full central heating, modern fitted kitchen, to name but a few.

The old, solid Oak front doors open into a spacious hall way and reception room, 37m2. at this level there is a door connection you to the double garage 45m2 and the cellar containing the Central heating boiler and oil tank. A stone arch leads you to the bottom of the original spiral stone and wooden staircase that goes all the way to the top floor.

On the first floor is a welcoming lounge 37m2 with high ceilings and big windows providing lots of natural light and a view into the town centre. In fact most of the rooms benefit from high ceilings and big windows. Also on this level is the recently upgraded, fully fitted modern kitchen/Diner with centre Isle and a wonderful stone fireplace, (not currently in use).

If your parties end up in the kitchen then you couldn't want for a better space, there is also a walk in larder. A door from the kitchen leads out onto the garden which is partly above the garage.
