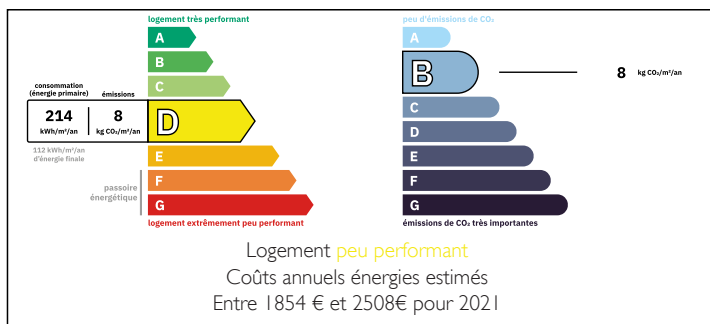

The well-renovated apartment consists of two bedrooms, kitchen/dining area, sitting room, separate WC and bathroom, with its very own medieval tower. There's a further two rooms off the tower, partially renovated, and below, a cellar with original 14th century wine racks. The tower staircase leads exclusively to the property, including the two further rooms which have views over the Creuse countryside, both ready for completion to extend the apartment or create a second property. Links to the Vatican have been a feature of St Gaultier's history, providing protection against destruction in the 100 Years War with the English. It's probably the only French town to be paid by the papacy in gold florins. Walk down the short hill opposite and you arrive at the riverbank for the Creuse, perfect for an evening stroll. The popular Friday market is a two-minute walk away. The town sits in the Parc de la Brenne, known for its' 3000+ lakes and great activities ranging from hiking and horseriding to canoeing, art workshops and live bands performing in Parc villages. Transport links are excellent with the A20 and TGV 10 minutes away airports at Limoges, Tours and Poitiers.
