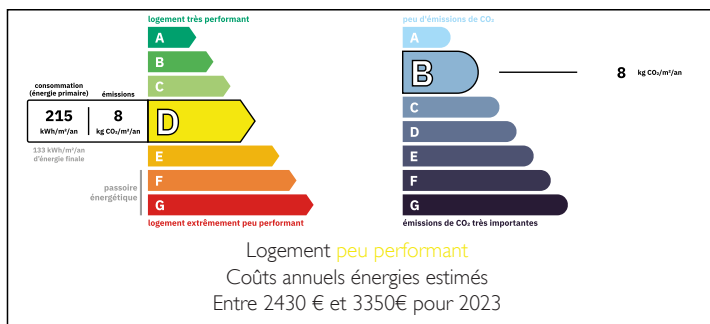

DESCRIPTION

On the ground floor, the garage provides space for two vehicles and also includes a workshop, utility/technical area, washing facilities, and an extra shower and WC.

Also on this level is a charming "smoking" room, warm and inviting, with a fireplace and an opening onto the orangery. This part of the house also includes a study or potential studio, together with the bright orangery overlooking the garden, providing a particularly pleasant additional living space.

Upstairs are the main living areas. The modern, fully fitted kitchen opens onto the terrace and enjoys lovely, far-reaching views towards the Pyrenees. The bright living room features a wood-burning stove and large patio doors for access to the terrace on two sides.

A spacious hallway leads to five bedrooms, one of which is currently used as a study and another as a second, air-conditioned sitting room. The bathroom and separate WC complete this floor.

All the bedrooms have wooden floors, while the other rooms have tiled flooring.

The kitchen and living room open onto a large east- and south-facing terrace, offering lovely open views across the garden and, in particular, towards the Pyrenean mountains. On a clear day, you can see the Château de Montségur, as well as the peaks of Soularac, Saint-Barthélemy and Fourcat.

The property also benefits from a large, established and fully enclosed garden, with a gated entrance and several private parking spaces. The 1,170 m² garden includes an old chicken coop, several fruit trees, rose bushes, a blue spruce, a magnolia...
