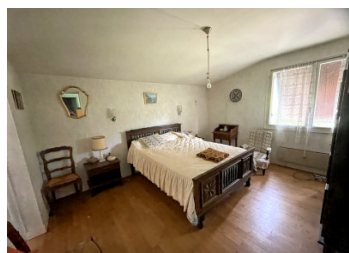
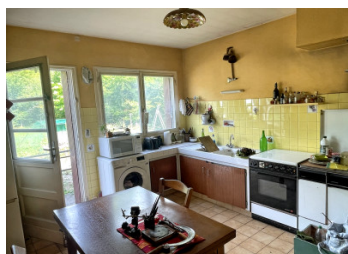

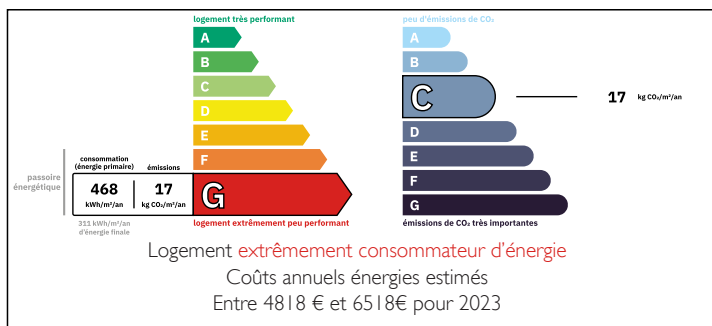
A peaceful green setting, generous proportions and plenty of potential.
