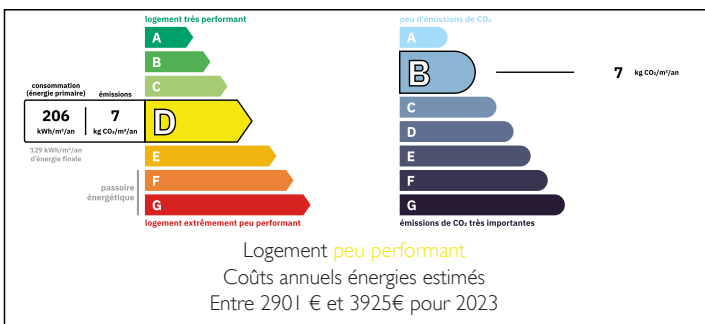

DESCRIPTION

Situated in a sought-after area of the Orb Valley, this beautiful winegrower's house offers a particularly pleasant living environment, in a quiet and secluded setting.

On arrival, it is the setting and the complete absence of neighbours opposite that immediately catch the eye. The property benefits from unspoilt surroundings and stunning views of the mountains, offering that rare feeling of being completely at home in a peaceful setting, whilst remaining close to the villages and the many activities the area has to offer.

On the ground floor, the spacious living and dining room makes for a lovely living area. The wooden flooring, the fireplace with its wood-burning stove and direct access to the large terrace under the pergola create a warm and welcoming atmosphere. The fitted kitchen opens onto a pleasant conservatory and also has access to the terrace. A beautiful master bedroom with en-suite bathroom also enjoys views of the mountains and access to the outdoors. A flight of stairs leads to the garden level, where a corridor converted into a library leads to the house's second entrance, which opens onto a bedroom with a study area, a small shower room and a toilet. This room has retained certain historic features linked to the property's former wine-making activity, notably traces of the old wine vats, which lend it a real sense of character.

From the outside, there is access to a summer kitchen, which also serves as a utility room, as well as to a separate...
