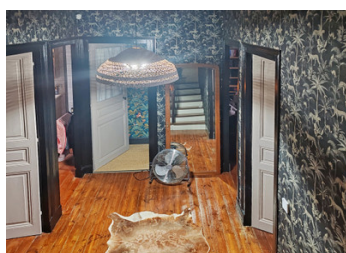
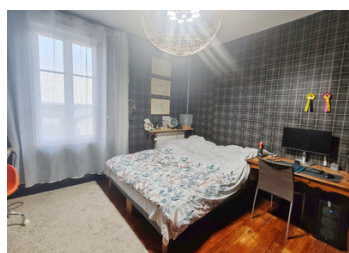

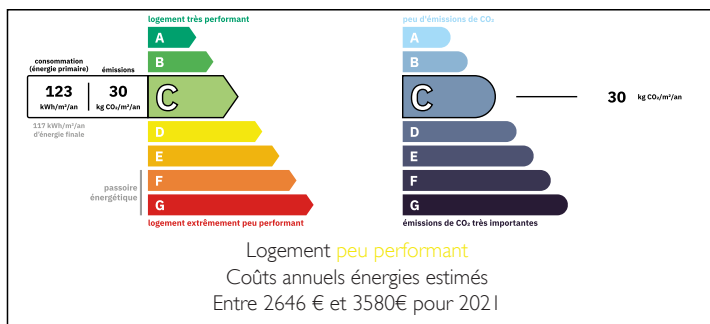

DESCRIPTION

In the heart of a classic French village, complete with post office, bakery and primary school, yet small enough that you can take a 5 minute stroll into the surrounding countryside, this atypical maison de maître has been thoughtfully renovated to work perfectly as either a permanent or holiday home.

The main door is actually to the side of the property, through which you are immediately welcomed into a warm and spacious entrance hall (13m²) with the staircase leading up at the far end. To your left there's a small corridor leading to the WC and a separate laundry room (6.2m²), which also contains the main fuseboard, the water softener, and more cupboard space than you are ever likely to fill. There is also a door from this room to the street out the front, although it is rarely used by the current owners. Further into the entrance hall, a wide opening on the left reveals a comfortable and spacious living room (21.5m²) with a window to the front. A similar opening on the other side of the hall leads to the incredibly well-equipped kitchen, which forms one branch of the open "L", the corner section housing the dining room with fireplace (currently purely decorative, although the flue is still there in the wall) and the other branch leads to the garden. This whole area measures approximately 26.5m². The whole of the ground floor is tiled apart from the living room which features a sisal-type...
