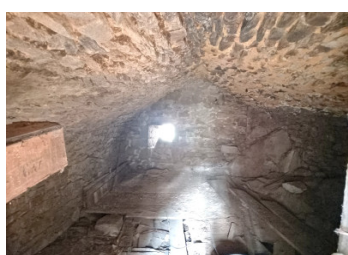
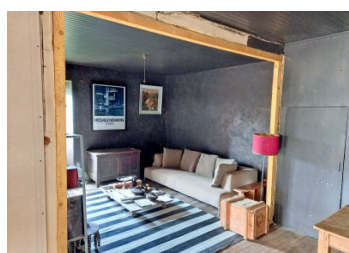

This charming village house in the historic town of Treignac offers a wonderful opportunity to create a beautiful French home while retaining many of its original features and character.

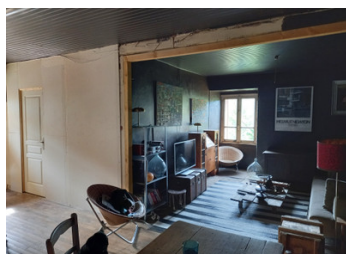
Partially renovated, the property provides a blank canvas for the new owner to complete and personalise, making it ideal for buyers looking for a character property with scope to add their own style and ideas.

The entrance hall leads to a 7m² bedroom and 3m² bathroom, while the elevated position means that the views can be enjoyed from virtually every room.

A staircase from the dining area provides access to the 35m² attic, which offers excellent potential for additional accommodation, subject to any necessary permissions. This versatile space could be transformed into further bedrooms, a studio, craft room, home office, gym or creative space, depending on your requirements.

Outside, the property benefits from three levels of secluded gardens, providing a surprising amount of private outdoor space within the town. There is also a well-maintained vaulted stone cave, ideal for storage or potentially wine storage, together with a 6m² workshop.
