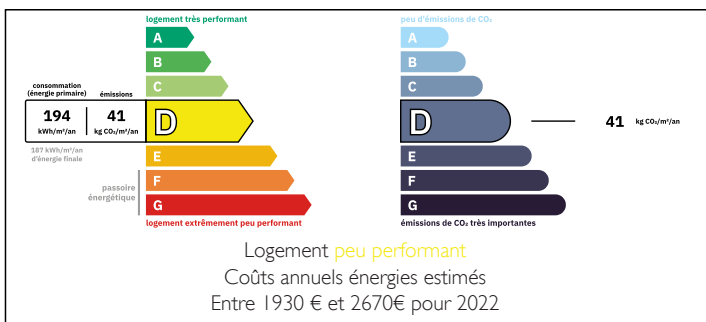

DESCRIPTION

Entering via the pedestrian gate, the stone terrace runs the length of the house up to the guest house. You enter directly into the fitted kitchen (20m²) with high ceiling and exposed beams. To the left is the dual aspect living room (43m²) with striking stone fireplace and door out to the terrace. Off this room is a shower room (7m²) with shower, sink and WC. Continuing through, the triple-aspect dining room (31m²) has a feature fireplace with glazed earthenware tiles. The ceiling is stencilled with a delicate flower design in green. A door gives access to the terrace and there is also a door giving access to a balcony overlooking the garden.

Off the living room, a stone and wooden spiral staircase dating from the 12th and 16th centuries connects to the first floor and garden level. Taking the staircase up to the first floor, there are two bedrooms. The first (16.5m²) has an ensuite shower room (7m²) with shower, sink and WC. The second bedroom (16m²) is reached via a corridor (5.5m²) and has a Juliette balcony.

Down the spiral staircase to garden level, off a hall (3m²) is a cinema room (13m²) which could be used as an additional bedroom, if desired. The master bedroom (26m²) is also at this level with feature fireplace and doors to a patio with garden access. The fireplace, ceiling and wall behind the bed are stencilled with a delicate flower design in blue. The ensuite bathroom...

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
