Looking for a character property to renovate ?

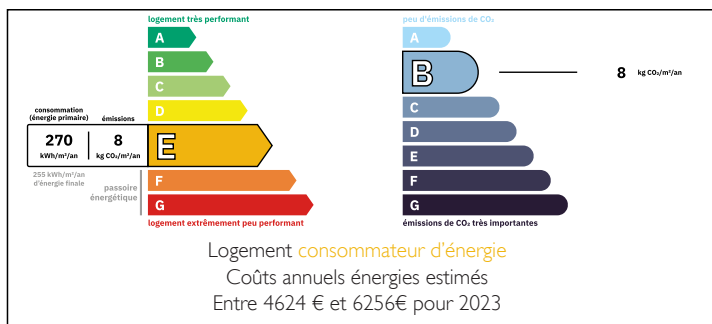

A separate outbuilding currently houses a garage, boiler room and utility/laundry area, and could also

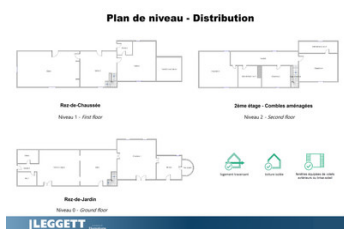
