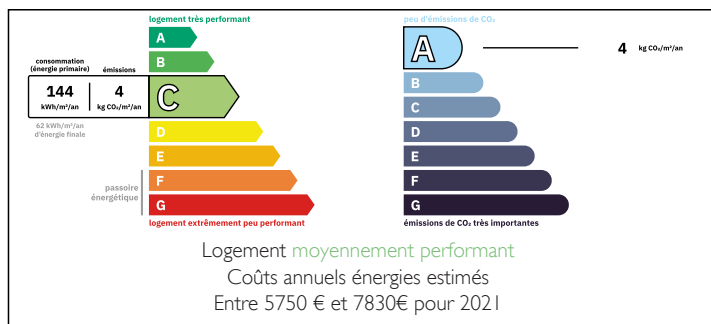

DESCRIPTION

Exceptional Château in Normandy – Just 2 Hours from Paris

Rare opportunity: Located only 130 km from Paris, at the gateway to Normandy, this exceptional 17th-century château, set within nearly 6 hectares of landscaped grounds, embodies French elegance and refinement.

A privileged setting

In the heart of the Pays d'Ouche, between Eure and Orne, the property benefits from a preserved and verdant environment. A majestic 300-metre tree-lined driveway leads to the château and its annexes, offering a unique and prestigious atmosphere from the very first approach.

The château

Built in 1630 and subsequently remodelled in the 19th century, the château is set on a crawl space (no humidity issues) and offers approx. 650 m² of living space, with 27 rooms across three levels.

Ground floor: The private living quarters are mainly on this level (with two additional bedrooms upstairs). Refreshing works are to be expected (painting, ceilings, and ground-floor electrics).

An entrance hall (6 m²) opens onto the east façade, while a second entrance leads to a bright 30 m² glazed gallery with wooden staircase. The ground floor includes: a 24 m² office with parquet flooring, a 30 m² laundry room, an 11 m² utility room with WC, a 29 m² parquet-floored salon with marble fireplace and moulded ceiling, a second 32 m² office, a 29 m² dining room with Renaissance fireplace (with original cast-iron radiators and terracotta floor tiles dating from 1630), a 21 m² kitchen with piano (to refurbish), a boiler room (8 m², with two 200L and two...
